#### A Guide for Completing Evidence Assessment

This skills audit is designed to be utilised when a staff member is being assessed as demonstrating safe and competent practice when performing hand hygiene and PPE application & removal. This assessment should be used in conjunction with your organisational guidelines, policies and procedures.

It can be used to assess practice in relevant situations, such as ahead of providing support or undertaking clinical tasks.



Procedure	Action performed correctly	Comments
Performing hand hygiene with soap and water		
<ul> <li>Wets hands under tepid running water first before applying liquid soap</li> </ul>		
<ul> <li>Uses enough soap to cover all surfaces of the hand</li> </ul>		
Rubs hands palm to palm		
<ul> <li>Rubs right palm over the back of the left hand with interlaced fingers and vice versa</li> </ul>		
<ul> <li>Rubs hands palm to palm with fingers interlaced</li> </ul>		
<ul> <li>Rubs the backs of fingers to opposing palms with fingers interlocked</li> </ul>		
<ul> <li>Rubs left thumb rotationally clasped in right hand and vice versa</li> </ul>		
<ul> <li>Rubs fingertips rotationally backwards and forwards in the opposite palm and vice versa</li> </ul>		
Rinses hands thoroughly with water		
Dries hands thoroughly with single use paper towels		
<ul> <li>Uses towel or elbow to switch off the tap</li> </ul>		
<ul> <li>Avoids recontamination of hands when disposing of towel in appropriate waste disposal bin</li> </ul>		
<ul> <li>Procedure lasts for a minimum of 20 seconds</li> </ul>		
Performing hand hygiene using alcohol hand rub		
<ul> <li>Applies alcohol hand rub in a cupped hand, enough to cover all surfaces of the hands and as per manufacturers recommended amount</li> </ul>		
Rubs hands palm to palm		
<ul> <li>Rubs right palm over the back of the left hand with interlaced fingers and vice versa</li> </ul>		
<ul> <li>Rubs hands palm to palm with fingers interlaced</li> </ul>	П	



•	Rubs the backs of fingers to opposing palms with fingers interlocked	
•	Rubs left thumb rotationally clasped in right hand and vice versa	
•	Rubs fingertips rotationally backwards and forwards in the opposite palm and vice versa	
•	Staff member identifies that hands must be dry to complete procedure	
•	Staff member continues the procedure until their hands are dry	
Applyi	ng PPE	
•	Staff member can explain which PPE is required and why	
•	Puts on <b>apron/gown</b> first, ensuring it is securely tied at the back	
•	Then, puts on <b>N95 respirator or surgical mask</b> – ensuring it is the appropriate type; that it covers mouth, nose and chin; fits flexible nose piece over bridge of nose; and secures firmly at the back of head or over the ears	
•	Then, puts on <b>protective eyewear or goggles</b> , ensuring they are appropriately secured	
•	Then, puts on <b>gloves</b> – selecting the appropriate type and size; extending gloves over cuffs if gown is being worn	
Remov	ving PPE	
•	Ensures PPE is removed and disposed of immediately following a clinical or support task to avoid spreading any contamination to the surrounding environment.  PPE (other than a mask) is removed in the client or resident's room	
•	Removes <b>gloves</b> first, by pinching and holding the outside of the first glove near the wrist area	



Peels the glove downwards, away from the wrist, turning the glove inside out as they go	
<ul> <li>Removes the glove from their hand, holding it within the gloved hand</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>With the un-gloved hand, slides fingers under the wrist of the remaining glove, taking care not to touch the outer surface of the glove</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Peels remaining glove downwards, away from the wrist, turning the glove inside out so that it encloses the other glove as they go</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Removes final glove, ensuring that both gloves are inside out, one glove enveloped inside the other, with any contamination contained on the inside and not on bare hands</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Places gloves straight into the appropriate waste disposal bin</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Performs hand hygiene following glove removal</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Removes protective eyewear or goggles, avoiding contact with front of protective eyewear or goggles, where contamination is likely, only touching the back or sides</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Ensures googles are placed in designated receptacle for washing if intended for multi-use, or disposed of into the appropriate waste disposal bin</li> </ul>	
Performs hand hygiene	
<ul> <li>Removes apron/gown by untying or breaking ties at the back and neck, only touching the inside of the gown, turning the apron/gown inside out as it is removed</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Folds or rolls apron/gown into a bundle to reduce the spread of contamination</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Disposes apron/gown in the appropriate waste disposal unit</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Leaves client or resident's room</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Removes N95 respirator or surgical mask, avoiding contact with front of mask where contamination is likely, breaking the ties at the back of the head and lifting the mask from face, only handling the ties</li> </ul>	
Discards mask in the appropriate waste disposal bin	
<ul> <li>Performs hand hygiene</li> </ul>
